

**BULK PICK-UP is April 16th!!**

Please have your household bulk items curbside Sunday April 15th. Trucks will be in our Village beginning Monday morning & once the truck has completed your street, it will not return.

**BULK ITEMS INCLUDE:**

Appliances, household items, furniture, gas grills (no tanks), hot water heaters, lawn chairs, Rugs (4ft in length, rolled & tied). Freon must be removed from refrigerators (doors removed), freezers and air conditioners before pick-up & tagged by a professional.

**DO NOT PUT OUT:**

Construction/renovation/demolition material, (wood, toilet, sink, bathtub, Cabinets, etc.), hazardous waste, yard debris, tires, gas tanks, fencing & metal.

**HOMEOWNERS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE THE FOLLOWING ITEMS TO THE TRANSFER STATION:**

Electronic equipment (TVs, Computers, Monitors, CPUs, Printers)
