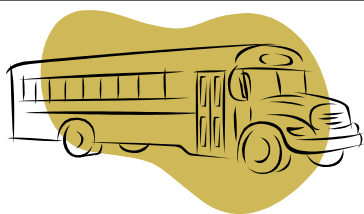

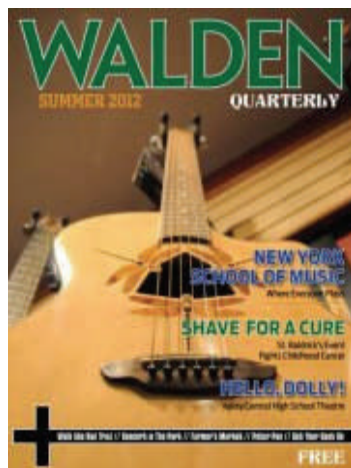
For kids it's the end of summer fun, for us commuters, it means we once again share the roadways during our morning drive. Leave yourself ample time to make those stops and arrive

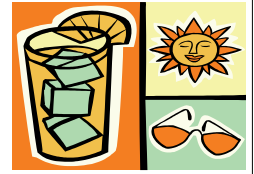

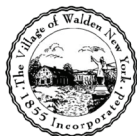
