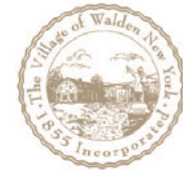

Municipal Square will be closed.

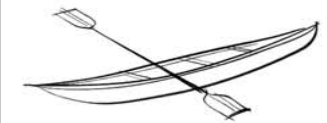

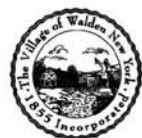
