Chapter 247 of Village Code—Addresses Solid Waste Collection and Disposal.

247-9 Containers: Placement and Removal. Trash shall be placed in suitable containers and shall have close fitting covers. All garbage, trash, recyclables and yard waste shall be placed at or within 3 feet of the curb or public street line for collection no earlier than 5:00pm on the day before collection and removed to a place invisible from the street by 9pm on the day of Collection.
