Halloween Safety Tips

1. Avoid Trick—or—Treating alone. Walk in groups or with a trusted adult.
2. Fasten reflective tape to costumes and bags to help drivers see you.
3. Examine all treats for choking hazards and tampering before eating them.
4. Hold a flashlight while Trick or Treating to help you see and others see you.
5. Look both ways before crossing the street.
6. Wear well—fitting masks, costumes, and shoes to avoid blocked vision, trips, and falls.
7. Eat only factory wrapped treats
8. Enter homes only if you're with a trusted adult. Don't stop at dark houses. Never accept rides from strangers.
9. Only walk on sidewalks whenever possible, or on the far edge of the road facing traffic to stay safe. Never RUN from house to house.
