A local law to establish a uniform fee schedule to be assessed by tow truck operators providing towing services within the Village of Walden

Section 1. Findings and Purpose:

The purpose of this Local Law is to establish a uniform fee schedule to be assessed by tow truck operators providing towing services within the Village of Walden pursuant to Chapter 277 of the Code of the Village of Walden.

Section 2. Section 277-1 shall be amended by deleting the first sentence and replacing it with the following:

No person, firm or corporation shall operate or hire a truck or other type of motor vehicle designed and able to provide road service to tow other motor vehicles from public places, streets or highways within the Village of Walden unless a license therefore shall first have been obtained from the Clerk for the Village of Walden as hereinafter provided and paid for in accordance with the Schedule of Fees for Tow Truck Operators as duly adopted by the Village of Walden Board of Trustees and as may be amended from time to time.

Section 3. Section 277-6(B) of the Code of the Village of Walden is hereby amended by deleting the last sentence in this paragraph (“*all licensed tow operators are authorized to collect fees scheduled in the Code of the Village of Walden in the event that the Village requests towing or impounding*”) and shall be replaced with the following:

All licensed tow operators are authorized to collect those fees set forth in the fee schedule for tow truck operators as adopted by the Village of Walden Board of Trustees and has may be amended from time to time and as is on file with the Office of the Village Clerk and the Village Police Department.

Section 4. SEQRA

4.1 This local law is an unlisted action pursuant to the implementing regulations of the *Environmental Conservation Law* as set forth at 6 NYCRR 617 et.seq. There are no other involved agencies, coordinated review is not required and Board of Trustees shall act as Lead Agency in connection with this local law.

Section 5. Severability

5.1 The invalidity or unenforceability of any particular provision of this local law shall not affect the validity or enforceability of other provisions of this local law, which such provisions shall continue to be both enforceable and valid.

Section 6. Effective Date

6.1 This local law shall take effect upon the filing of certified copies thereof with the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
