

the boundaries of the properties in order to limit the visual impact of these new homes. Rain Gardens will be built with each house to better manage storm water.

Jose DeJesus expressed his concern about the impact to the existing wetlands.

John Katona, 194 River Road, expressed concerns about the wet lands, water runoff and agricultural zoning concerns for his property. He explained that he would like to see more vegetation added to the area.

Stan Plato said that the wetlands would be staked so that they wouldn't be disturbed by the new residents.

Eric Crossley, 201 South Montgomery Street, said that when he purchased his house he was told that the wetlands were federally protected and that they would never be developed on. He said that there are many animals that will lose their homes if the property is developed.

Walt Thronsen, Donna Crysty Lane, expressed his concerns about the condition of the houses in the wetlands. He said that he has put fill in his yard because the ground sinks.

Jose DeJesus made a motion to close the public hearing.

Seconded by Jay Wilkins.

All ayes.

Motion carried.

Kevin Dowd explained to the board that the Walden United Methodist Church is asking the board to make amendments to the zoning map so the property can be sold with greater ease.

Jay Wilkins made a motion to adjourn.
Seconded by Jose DeJesus.
