A local law to amend Chapter 291, Article VI, Section 291-14 of the Code of the Village of Walden

Section 1. Findings and Purpose. The purpose of this local law is to amend Chapter 291, Article VI, Section 291-14 of the Code of the Village of Walden by the addition of a stop intersection and installation of stop signs for the express purpose of improving traffic control as well as promoting vehicular and pedestrian safety.

Section 2. Section 291-14 shall be amended by adding the following designated areas as a stop intersection and stop signs shall be erected as indicated:

Stop Sign on	Direction of Travel	Intersection of
Highland Avenue	North	Sadlier Place and Oakland Avenue
Highland Avenue	South	Sadlier Place and Oakland Avenue
Sadlier Place	East	Highland Avenue
Oakland Ave	West	Highland Avenue

Section 3. This local law is enacted pursuant to the authority of the Municipal Home Rule Law and General Municipal Law §103(1).

Section 4. SEQRA

4.1 This local law is an unlisted action pursuant to the implementing regulations of the *Environmental Conservation Law* as set forth at *6 NYCRR 617 et.seq.* There are no other involved agencies, coordinated review is not required and Board of Trustees shall act as Lead Agency in connection with this local law.

Section 5. Severability

5.1 The invalidity or unenforceability of any particular provision of this local law shall not affect the validity or enforceability of other provisions of this local law, which such provisions shall continue to be both enforceable and valid.

Section 6. Effective Date

6.1 This local law shall take effect upon the filing of certified copies thereof with the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
