A local law to amend Chapter 291 [Vehicles and Traffic] of the Code of the Village of Walden

Section 1. Findings and Purpose:

The purpose of this Local Law is to amend Chapter 291 [Vehicles and Traffic], specifically section 291-22 of the Code of the Village of Walden, to provide an additional designated parking restriction during school hours location.

Section 2. Section 291-22 entitled “**Parking Restrictions During School Hours**” of the Code of the Village of Walden shall be amended by the addition of new regulated “parking during school hours” location as follows:

| <u>Name of Street</u> | <u>Side</u> | <u>Time Limit: Hours/Days</u> | <u>Location</u> |
|-----------------------|-------------|---|---|
| Maple Street | North | Monday – Friday 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. | From the terminus of the existing “No Parking” Zone at the intersection of Walnut Street and Maple Street a distance of 112 feet ending at the next designated “No Parking” area. |

Section 3. SEQRA

4.1 This local law is an unlisted action pursuant to the implementing regulations of the *Environmental Conservation Law* as set forth at *6 NYCRR 617 et.seq.* There are no other involved agencies, coordinated review is not required and Board of Trustees shall act as Lead Agency in connection with this local law.

Section 4. Severability

5.1 The invalidity or unenforceability of any particular provision of this local law shall not affect the validity or enforceability of other provisions of this local law, which such provisions shall continue to be both enforceable and valid.

Section 5. Effective Date

6.1 This local law shall take effect upon the filing of certified copies thereof with the Office of the Secretary of State in accordance with the Municipal Home Rule Law.
