

## **LOCAL LAW 2 OF 2019**

### **A LOCAL AMENDING CHAPTER 291 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WALDEN ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” TO THE EXTENT OF DELETING SECTION 291-7(A)**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Village Board of the Village of Walden as follows:

#### **SECTION 1 - TITLE**

This Local Law shall be referred to as “A Local Law Amending Chapter 291 of the Code of the Village of Walden entitled “Vehicle and Traffic” to the extent of deleting Section 291-7(A).”

#### **SECTION 2 – PURPOSE & INTENT**

In order to alleviate congestion and otherwise improve the flow of traffic in and around Orchard Street in the vicinity of the intersection of Main and Orchard Streets, it is determined to be in the overall public interest to repeal Section 291-7(A) of the Village Code which established a loading zone on the westerly side of Orchard Street starting from a point 70 feet in a southwesterly direction from the southwest corner of the intersection of Main and Orchard Streets to a point 100 feet southwesterly therefrom.

#### **SECTION 3 – AMENDMENT TO TEXT OF CODE SECTION 291-7(A)**

Existing Code Section 291-7(A) is hereby repealed. The remaining five paragraphs in this section shall be re-lettered accordingly.

#### **SECTION 4 - VALIDITY**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

#### **SECTION 5- EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
