

## **LOCAL LAW 6 OF 2019**

### **A LOCAL LAW AMENDING CHAPTER 291 OF THE CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF WALDEN ENTITLED “VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC” TO THE EXTENT OF AMENDING SECTION 291-18 TO ESTABLISH A NEW HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE**

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Village Board of the Village of Walden as follows:

#### **SECTION 1 - TITLE**

This Local Law shall be referred to as “A Local Law Amending Chapter 291 of the Code of the Village of Walden entitled “Vehicle and Traffic” to the extent of amending Section 291-18 to establish a new handicapped parking space.

#### **SECTION 2 – PURPOSE & INTENT**

The purpose of this Local Law is to provide an additional handicapped parking space to insure adequate parking accessibility by providing sufficient parking locations for handicapped persons subject to the requirements of Village Code Section 291-18

**SECTION 3 – AMENDMENT TO TEXT OF CODE SECTION 291-18.** The existing Code Section 291-18 is amended by the addition of the following paragraphs which establishes a location for a new handicapped parking space:

- L. Pine Street, in the area between 45 feet and 68 feet north of the intersection of Orchard Street and Pine Street on the westerly side of Pine Street.

#### **SECTION 4 - VALIDITY**

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

#### **SECTION 5- EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary of State in accordance with Section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.
