## Village of Walden Residential Garbage Customers...

(commercial refuse customers are not included in residential bulk pick up)

Please have your household bulk items curbside on Sunday, October 18, 2020. Trucks will be going through our Village from October 19 - October 23, 2020 with all items picked up by Friday, October 23rd.

Once the truck has completed your street, it will NOT return.

<u>BULK ITEMS INCLUDE:</u> Appliances (please note: refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners **MUST** have Freon removed before pickup & be tagged by a professional and the doors need to be removed), furniture, hot water heaters, gas grills (no tanks), lawn chairs, and Rugs (must be rolled & tied in 4ft lengths).

**DO NOT PUT OUT:** Construction/renovation/demolition materials (ie: wood, toilets, sinks, bathtubs, cabinets, paint cans, etc.), hazardous waste, yard debris, tires, gas tanks, or fencing & metal, or electronic equipment\*\* (TV's, Computers, Monitors, CPU's, Printers, etc.). (Please be advised that these items will NOT be picked up & if left curbside after the truck has gone down your street, you may be subject to a violation of Village Code)

\*\*Please be advised that printers, fax machines, computer monitors and towers, scanners, small servers, cables/wires, laptops, cell and smart phones, tablets, video game consoles, DVD players, VCR's, and digital music players can be brought to the Orange County Transfer Stations as they will now accept these items free of charge. Televisions will also be accepted at a rate of \$5 per unit with no restriction on size. Small appliances, microwaves and vacuum cleaners will not be accepted. \*\*

There may be reduced pressure at times due to water flow and closing of valves throughout the distribution system. We apologize for any inconvenience, but this is necessary to remove debris that naturally accumulates in the mains

Call the Village of Walden Water Department with any questions or concerns Monday – Friday between the hours of 7am and 3:30pm (845) 778-2177 ext. 1522 Everyone is reminded that their home or business must have a 911 number that shall be legible and placed in a position that is visible from the street or roadway fronting the property. The 911 number shall not be spelled out and each character shall not be less than 4" high and shall not contrast with their backgrounds.
