There may be reduced pressure at times due to water flow and closing of valves throughout the distribution system. We apologize for any inconvenience, but this is necessary to remove debris that naturally accumulates in the mains.



#### Yard Waste Pick Up Resumes Thursdays, Beginning April 7th

Yard waste clippings (grass/leaves) may be put in *Paper* Lawn Bags or

in regular garbage cans with the lids left off so the garbage company can clearly see it is yard waste in the can. Any sticks or branches must be bundled together in no more than 4 foot lengths. Items should go out Wednesday evenings for Thursday morning pick up.

#### **Grass Cutting Code Reminder:**

Spring is here and with that brings new growth, which includes your lawn!

Just a friendly reminder of the Village of Walden Code on grass/weed cutting:

Per the Village Code Chapter 105, Section 105-2: Growth of weeds, grass or other rank vegetation to a height greater than five (5) inches or any accumulation of dead grass, weeds or brush is prohibited.

Failure to comply with this code will result in the Village undertaking the cutting and/or clean up, and presenting you, as the owner, with a bill for services to cut said grass, brush, and weeds/clean up. If you have any questions please call the office at 845-778-2177 ext.1505.



#### **BULK PICK UP DETAILS:**

Village of Walden Residential Garbage Customers...

Please have your household bulk items curbside on Sunday, April 24, 2022. Trucks will be going through our Village from April 25 - April 29, 2022 with all items picked up by Friday, April 29th.

Once the truck has completed your street, it will NOT return.

#### **BULK ITEMS INCLUDE:**

Appliances, furniture, hot water heaters, gas grills (no tanks), lawn chairs, Rugs (4ft in length, rolled & tied). Freon MUST be removed before pickup & tagged by a professional for all refrigerators, freezers and air conditioners (doors need to be removed as well).

**DO NOT PUT OUT:** Construction/renovation/demolition materials (ie: wood, toilets, sinks, bathtubs, doors, windows, cabinets, paint cans, etc.), hazardous waste, yard debris, tires, gas tanks, or fencing & metal, or electronic equipment (ie: TV's, Computers, Monitors, CPU's, Printers, etc.).

(Please be advised that these items will NOT be picked up & if left curbside after the truck has gone down your street, you will be subject to a violation of Village Code)
