This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Amending Chapter 291 of the Code of the Village of Walden entitled "Vehicle and Traffic" to the extent of amending Section 291-19 relative to the parking on East Avenue.

Be it enacted by the <u>Village Board</u> (Name of Legislative Body) of the County City of <u>Walden</u> as follows: Village

Section 1. <u>Title</u>

This Local Law shall be referred to as "A Local Law Amending Chapter 291 of the Code of the Village of Walden entitled "Vehicle and Traffic" to the extent of amending Section 291-19 relative to the parking on East Avenue.

Section 2. – <u>Purpose and Intent</u>

The purpose of this Local Law is to establish a "no parking" area on East Avenue to ensure public safety for both vehicles and pedestrians.

Section 3. – <u>Amendment to text of Code Section 291-19</u>.

Existing Code Section 291-19 is hereby amended to provide as follows:

Section 4. – <u>Validity</u>

If any clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part of this local law shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder thereof, but shall be confined in its operation to the clause, sentence, paragraph, word, section or part thereof directly involved in the controversy in which such judgment shall have been rendered.

Section 5. – <u>Effective Date</u>

This Local Law shall take effect immediately when it is filed in the Office of the New York State Secretary
